In addition to their many fun activities for area newcomers, the League recently introduced a new activity called “Pay It Forward.” Each month, the group will engage in a different and unique charitable activity. “We feel our organization has the time and energy to put forth lending a hand to many ongoing initiatives in the Dayton area,” said Amy Walsh, Director of NNL of Dayton.

Many of the members are currently working on a Mother’s Day project providing gift bags for the women served by the Artemis Center, an organization that provides early intervention, supportive services, and education for victims of domestic violence and their children. “We have collected basic personal items, such as soap, shampoo, toothpaste, etc, and assembled them into gift bags for the women,” said Walsh.

In June, the NNL will visit Hannah’s Treasure Chest to assist in one of their projects, learn about ongoing and future projects, and how NNL can get involved. Hannah’s Treasure Chest, founded in 2001 by Angela Addington, provides clothing, furniture, and toys to enrich the lives of local children.

New Neighbors League of Dayton is a not-for-profit social organization founded in 1939. The club provides a wide variety of activities and hosts a monthly luncheon highlighted by a guest speaker. The NNL started here in Dayton and is now one of 14 such clubs around the country.
